5. We acknowledge that our sins and failings have created new obstacles between our fellow Christians and ourselves and left many older barriers untouched, and so we pray: **R.**
6. *Pause for those who wish to add an intercession*
7. Grant eternal rest to our beloved faithful departed. **R.**

V. O God, come to our aid

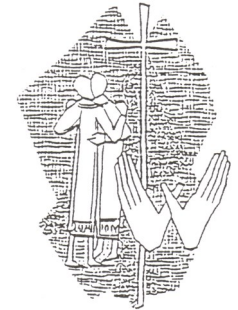
R. O Lord, make haste to help us.
